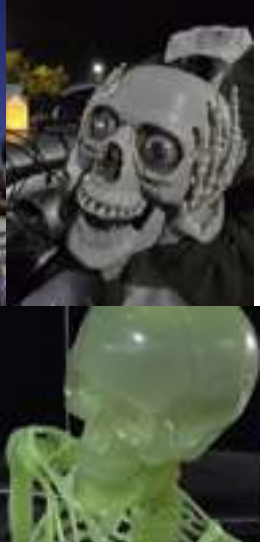


CONGRATULATIONS!
