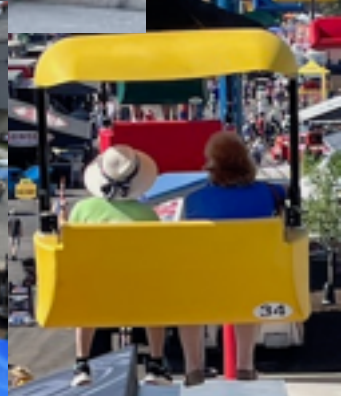
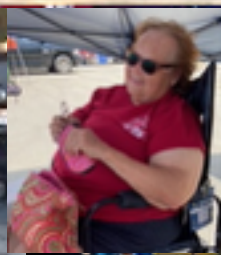

NEW MVA RULE HB352

Effective July 1, 2025

A new definition of historic vehicles (Class L).

The current "at least 20 years old" is replaced by
"model years of 1999 or older."

That means that model years 2000-2005 vehicles
that are currently historic must convert to a
standard registration.

These vehicles will also be subject to VEIP
requirements and if there is no record of a safety
inspection by the current owner,
a safety inspection.

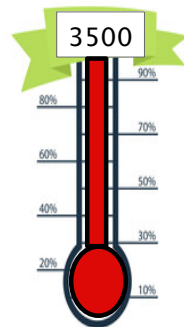
