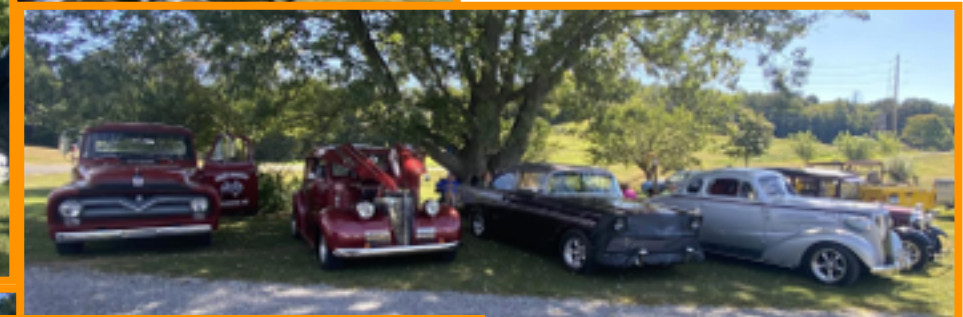

ON THE ROAD AGAIN -THIS TIME PIGEON FORGE, TN

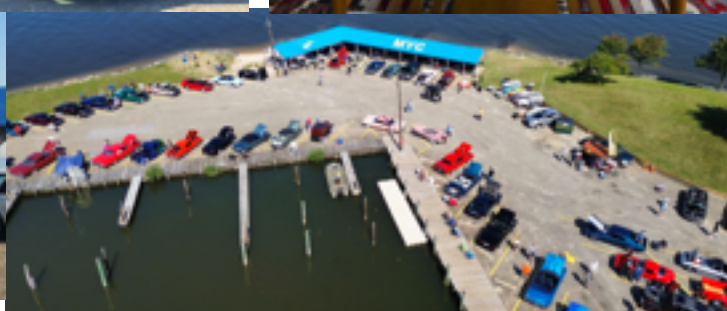
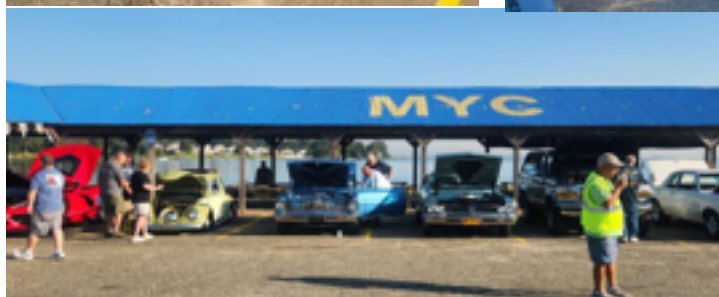
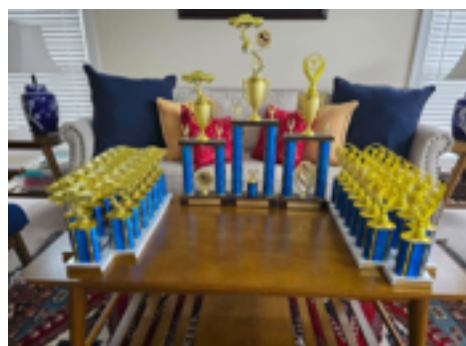
