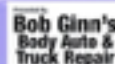

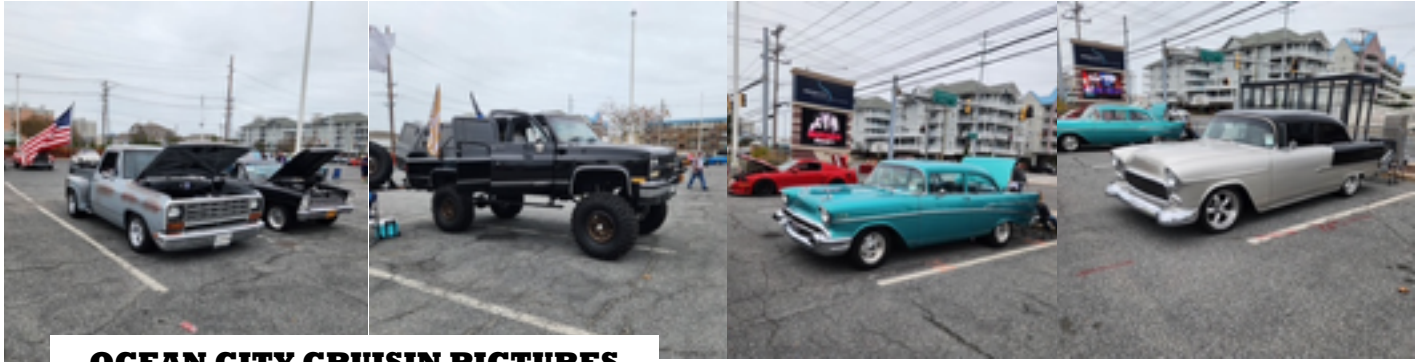

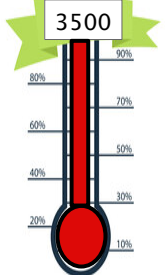

Posted in Maryland car meets today.10/12/26

Hey everyone, last night our monthly chill spot in Anne Arundel county was shut down by Anne Arundel county police. I took the time to walk over and talk to the 2 officers after they turned on their lights and told us all to leave.

They were respectful and explained simply after the events that took place in Pigeon Forge, TN (Gat) they've been instructed to shut down any gatherings of modified vehicles in all of AACO which they perceive as "staging to street race or disrupt the surrounding areas". They also cited the month before someone reported the black BWM sliding around the parking lot leaving tire marks which the property owner is no longer allowing gatherings after businesses close moving forward. (Thanks jackass)

I explained that we've been meeting here since may this year and has been our meet up spot for years and we are against the takeover and clout culture that causes problems and are a chill group that just enjoys networking and connecting with other car enthusiasts. We actively tell people to respect the spot and we come and go without disrupting the local businesses and if someone does come through to disrupt, we make it known they're not welcome back.

The officers said they appreciate us being "the good guys" but find a spot that will provide us written permission and make sure it's with you if someone asks you to leave. AACO police is stopping car meets before they get to a point where they start receiving complaints about loud cars racing or revving at each other all night and only growing into something bigger and more of a problem.

He said if we wanted he could just call in 10 more cars to block the exits and ticket everyone for illegal mods cause he can see from where he's standing illegal tint, loud exhaust pipes, suspension, but he's giving us a chance to move along first. Next he said we should go find a property that allows us to hang out and then they don't have to keep coming out to parking lots and telling people to leave.

I told them I appreciated them taking the time to talk and I wouldn't hold them up from whatever else they have going on that's probably more important, but we just wanted them to know that there is a line in the sand forming. There are people who are pushing back against the people actively ruining our culture.

Lastly I told him that while the security for the lot did give us permission, we'll reach out to the property owners as well to see if they'll give us permission to continue our event in the future.

If you read this far, please know that every car you make an excuse for that wants to lay on their rev limiter, slide and do burnouts and just drive recklessly through your spot, they will be the next reason police are going to use to shut you and potentially your county down from having meet ups in the future. If they haven't already.

If you're part of this problem or these types of people, you're not welcome, you're ruining what we're trying to build.
