As of July 1, 2025, Maryland tightened historic vehicle registration, changing the requirement from a rolling 20-year age to a fixed **1999 or older model year**. This change impacts thousands of vehicles, removing exemptions for emissions and inspections. Owners of 2000+ model year vehicles must switch to standard registration upon renewal.

Key Changes and Information:

- **Eligibility Cutoff:** Vehicles must be 1999 model year or older, not just 20+ years old.
- **Expiration/Renewals:** Existing tags for vehicles 2000 and newer will not be renewed once they expire, with many expiring in early 2026.
- **Impact on Owners:** Affected vehicles must pass a safety inspection and emissions tests to obtain standard tags.
- **Proposed Legislation:** Proposals in 2026 suggest changing this to a rolling 25-year, or 30-year rule, to replace the 1999 fixed date.
